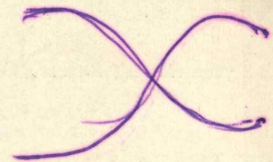

Tickets are available at the Public Library, North Street, Guildford, Telephone 68496, open Mondays to Fridays 10.00 am to 7.00 pm, Saturdays 10.00 am to 4.00 pm. Postal applications must include a stamped addressed envelope and a cheque or postal order payable to Guildford Corporation. Telephone bookings must be collected and paid for not less than two days before the concert. During the hour before the concert begins, tickets may be obtained from the Civic Hall Box Office (Telephone 67314), but it is advisable to book in advance, or check by telephone that tickets are still available, because the concerts are sometimes sold out.
